CONFIRM PRINTED PAPER SIZE



1. BEFORE PRINTING THIS PAGE, ENSURE THAT PAGE SCALING IS SET TO "NONE" ON YOUR PRINT DIALOG BOX.
2. MEASURE THE BAR AT LEFT TO ENSURE IT'S EXACTLY 50 MILLIMETRES LONG.
3. IF THE MEASUREMENT IS NOT ACCURATE, THEN CHECK YOU ARE PRINTING THE PAGE AT FULL SIZE AND REPRINT BEFORE CONTINUING.

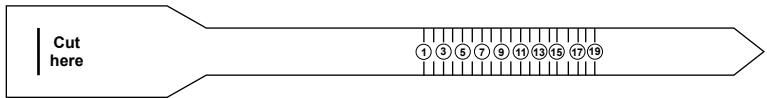
METHOD A - MEASURE FINGER WITH PAPER SIZER

1. Carefully cut along outline of the sizer, don't forget the small slit at the left hand end.
2. Wrap the sizer around the intended finger with the numbers facing out.
3. Slide the pointed end of the sizer through the slit.
4. Move the sizer to the largest part of the finger, this might be the knuckle.
5. **Pull tightly, as the sizer must fit firmly to give an accurate size.**
6. The number that lines up at the slit represents the ring size on the circle chart below.

TIPS FOR ACCURATE MEASURING

Avoid measuring cold fingers as this is when your fingers are their smallest.

Measure fingers at the end of the day, this is when fingers are at their largest.



METHOD B - MEASURE CURRENT RING

1. Select a ring that already properly fits the intended finger.
2. Place the ring over the circles below & match the inside of the ring to the nearest circle size.
3. If the ring falls between two sizes, then order the larger size.
